Corrections were made to the May and June special indices that were published on 4 September 2020. The changes were made due to computational errors.

Below is an overview of the changes that were made to the Consumer Price Index special indices.

In May 2020, the year on year All Items Less Food index rose 1.1%, the All Items less Energy index increased 1.3% and the All Items Less Food and Energy index increased by 1.2%. The month to month All Items Less Food index rose 0.8%, the All Items Less Energy index increased 0.6% and the All Items Less Food and Energy index increased 0.9%.

In June 2020, the year on year All Items Less Food index rose 1.1%, the All Items less Energy index increased 1.2% and All Items Less Food and Energy index increased by 1.1%. The month to month All Items Less Food index remained unchanged, the All Items Less Energy index increased 0.1% and the All Items Less Food and Energy index remained unchanged. Below is a summary of the corrections:
